Hunters have 10 days to report a successful harvest of Deer, Elk, Bear, and Cougar.  
Hunters have until April 10<sup>th</sup> to report successful Waterfowl harvest, Species and Numbers.  
Hunters have until April 10<sup>th</sup> to report on all tags regardless of whether an animal is harvested.  
Failure to report by April 10<sup>th</sup> will result in loss of hunting privileges for the following hunting season.
