Hunters have up to 10 days to report a successful harvest of Deer, Elk, Bear, and Cougar.  
 Hunters have until April 10<sup>th</sup> to report successful Waterfowl harvest, species, and quantity.  
 Hunters have until April 10<sup>th</sup> to report on all tags regardless of whether an animal is harvested.

**Failure to report by April 10<sup>th</sup> will result in a \$200.00 administrative fee and loss of special permit eligibility the following seasons until the fee is paid in full.**
