

STILLAGUAMISH TRIBE HUNTING SEASON REGULATIONS 2026-2027

TRIBAL HUNTING OPEN IN GMU'S

203, 218, 244, 245, 249, 336, 346, 407, 410, 411, 412, 413, 414, 415, 416, 417, 418, 420, 421, 426, 437, 448, 450, 454, 460, 466, 485, 490, 627, 653

Without waiving any claim or legal argument with respect to the nature, scope, or geographic extent of the Stillaguamish Tribe's Treaty hunting rights, the eastern border of that area, which will be open for hunting will be the pacific crest trail or the eastern borders of Whatcom, Skagit, Snohomish, King, and Pierce counties, whichever is furthest east. Portions of the GMU's that apply to this description are: 203, 218, 244, 245, 249, 336, 346, 426, 448, 450, 460, and 466.

Sept. 1, 2026 – Jan. 31, 2027 Either Sex in GMU's: 203, 218, 244, 245, 249, 407, 410- 418, 426, 437, 448, 450, 460, 466, 490, 627

Sept. 1, 2026 – Dec. 31, 2026 Buck Only in GMU's: 336, 346, 485, 653

ELK

Limit of 1

Sept. 1, 2026 -Jan. 31, 2027 Either sex in GMU's: 407, 450, 454

Feb. 1, 2027 - March 31, 2027 Bull only in GMU's: 407, 450, 454

Sept. 1, 2026 - Dec. 31, 2026 Bull only in GMU's: 245, 249, 336, 346, 460, 466, 485, 490, 653

Sept. 1, 2026 - March 31, 2027 Bull only in GMU: 437

*Sept. 1, 2026 -March 31, 2027 Bull only in GMU: 418

**Sept. 1, 2026 – Dec. 31, 2026 Cow only in GMU: 437 (Skagit River Valley)

BEAR

Limit of 4

May 1, 2026 - Nov. 30, 2026 Either sex (avoid shooting sow with cubs)

COUGAR

Limit of 2

April 1, 2026 – March 31, 2027 Either sex

SPECIAL PERMITS

- *Only permit holders for GMU 418 can take an elk from this GMU. GMU 418 permit holders are also authorized to hunt in the Skagit River Valley between Sedro-Woolley and Marblemount. Special permits in GMU 418 may consist of a subsistence or ceremonial permit.
- **A special cow elk hunt in GMU 437 (Skagit River Valley between Sedro-Woolley and Marblemount) will occur for the 2026-27 season. This permit may consist of a subsistence or ceremonial permit.
- Mountain goat is closed to subsistence hunting. Ceremonial permit may be issued for male goats only.
- Ceremonial hunts for all big and small game are year round and any sex, unless specified.


MIGRATORY BIRDS

Ducks (Dabbling/Diving)	Oct. 1, 2026 - March 10, 2027	15 per day
Coot	Oct. 1, 2026 - Jan. 31, 2027	25 per day
Band-tailed Pigeon	Sept. 1, 2026 - Oct. 31, 2027	4 per day
Canada Goose	Sept. 1, 2026 - March 10, 2027	10 per day
White Geese	Sept. 1, 2026 - March 10, 2027	20 per day
White-fronted Goose	Sept. 1, 2026 - March 10, 2027	12 per day
Swans	Oct. 1, 2026 - March 10, 2027	6 per year (Ceremonial Only)

TRIBAL LANDS

Archery/Crossbow Restricted Area:

- Arlington, Stillaguamish Community Center and all adjacent properties (known as the '80 acres') located at 24410 55th Ave NE.
- Arlington, from I-5 at exit 210 (236th St. NE), east along 236th St. NE to 35th Ave NE, south to the Stillaguamish River, west along the Stillaguamish River back to I-5 and north to exit 210 (236th St NE).
- It is the responsibility of the individuals to also verify No Shooting Areas listed by the Snohomish County No Shooting Area Maps prior to hunting activities (<https://snohomishcountywa.gov/DocumentCenter/View/265/No-Shooting-Area-Map-PDF?bidId=>)
- All Stillaguamish Tribal lands in Snohomish County west of HWY 9 are archery, muzzleloader, shotgun and pistol only, unless otherwise posted or by Council Resolution.
- Do not shoot collared animals. If one is harvested, return collar or tag to the Wildlife Department.
